## MAKE YOUR OWN TIME CAPSULE

*Why not have a go at making your own time capsule, just like Max's grandma!  
It is a wonderful way of capturing a moment in time that future generations  
— or even just your adult self — will love to look back on.*

### **Step 1: Choose a capsule**

If you plan to bury your time capsule, you'll need to use a sealable container such as a jam jar or a biscuit tin. For an indoor time capsule, a shoebox is a great option. If you have a specific date in mind for when the time capsule should be opened, make sure to write it on the outside of the container.

### **Step 2: Gather some treasures**

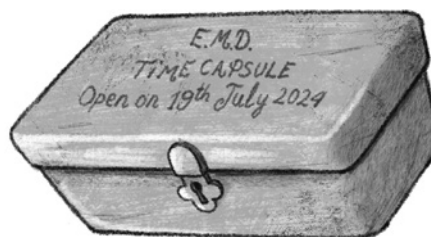
For someone opening up the capsule in fifty or a hundred years, even the simplest of everyday objects will be fascinating: cinema tickets, receipts, recipe cards, toy figurines, coins or stamps. Why not include a letter all about yourself and your day-to-day life? Who knows, it might end up in a museum one day!

### **Step 3: Pack your objects**

Pack your treasures into the capsule. Consider using individual waterproof bags for each item to help prevent moisture getting in. You could label each bag to explain the item inside. Remember not to include anything perishable, like food or liquids.

### **Step 4: Hide your capsule**

You could bury your capsule outside, or find somewhere else where it won't be disturbed such as an attic space or under a loose floorboard.



### **Final tip!**

Make sure to keep a note of where the time capsule is hidden so that future generations know where to find it.
